## [H.R. 891, to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 141 Paloma Drive in Floresville, Texas, as the “Floresville Veterans Post Office Building”](#)

### FLOOR SITUATION

On Monday, June 15, 2015, the House will consider [H.R. 891](#), *to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 141 Paloma Drive in Floresville, Texas, as the “Floresville Veterans Post Office Building,”* under suspension of the rules. H.R. 891 was introduced on February 11, 2015, by Rep. Henry Cuellar (D-TX) and was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, which ordered the bill reported, by unanimous consent, on May 19, 2015.

### SUMMARY

H.R. 891 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 141 Paloma Drive in Floresville, Texas, as the “Floresville Veterans Post Office Building.”

### BACKGROUND

Texas has the second largest population of veterans in the United States.<sup>1</sup> According to Texas Governor Greg Abbott, “Saying ‘thank you’ is not enough to those who risked their lives for our nation’s freedom.”<sup>2</sup>

### COST

A Congressional Budget Office (CBO) cost estimate is currently unavailable.
